TOPIC: With the redesign of the nursing care plan activity limitations with NANDA and NOC terminology were found.

BACKGROUND: This presentation will address the limitations found, the revision of diagnoses and outcomes and the submission of new terms for both NANDA and NOC. It will explain the process and the experience. It will also outline plans for future use, for example... using NANDA, NIC and NOC for development of nursing protocols and patient education.

DESCRIPTION: We will discuss the diagnoses revised along with the rationale for the proposed changes. The steps for developing new diagnoses will also be reviewed along with the process for submitting the new terms for review and publication. We will include the process used by staff at Aspirus Wausau Hospital for revising and developing nursing diagnoses. The project also required some additional outcomes focused on the acute care patient's needs. The revision and development of nursing outcomes will also be discussed.

CONCLUSIONS: Lessons learned for reviewing and submitting both will also be included in the presentation.
